## **School Specialty & Students Development**

1. Students Courses



- 1) Reading Program:
  - Promote daily morning reading for 15 minutes to develop good reading habits.
  - Establish "The Love Suku" (The Mobile Library) of Emei Township to enrich the resources for the school library.





- 2) Science Education:
  - Seek sponsorship from the community to establish the Science Club for Grade 1 ~ Grade 4 students at school, which students can have the hand-on scientific experiences.
  - Implement the exploring local ecology course by combining the school's outdoor education program. So the students can learn variety of the natural resources of Emei Township.

- 3) Physical Education:
  - Baseball The school represented Hsinchu County for the 2013 National Baseball League Match (Elementary Schools).
  - Volleyball Fu-Sing School girls' volleyball team came 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 2012 Hsinchu County Schools Volley ball Competition.
